








What is the has got/ have got?



Have got / has got meaning possession of something

She, he and it change the auxiliary by has



Structure of have got/has got

Affirmative

S+ has got / have got+ noun+ complement

Negative

S+ has not got / have not got+ noun+ complement

Interrogative

Have / has+ S+ noun+ complement

Contractions: Hasn't got...... Haven't got
